High Peaks Hospice has an immediate opening for a **full-time After-Hours RN** in our Southern clinical office serving Warren and northern Washington counties of New York. The After-Hours Nurse is responsible for triaging issues and visiting terminally ill patients and families as needed. Our After-Hours RNs work after hours Friday 4pm thru the following Friday 8am, one week on, one week off.

Responsibilities include:

- Assisting patients, family members or other clients with concern and empathy; respecting confidentiality and privacy and communicating in a courteous and respectful manner.
- Providing direct care to patients as prescribed in the Plan of Care in order to maintain the highest level of comfort and quality of life.
- Instructing the patient and caregiver how to administer medication and recognize side-effects; how to perform personal care and oral hygiene; how to assist in lifting, moving, and ambulation; how to prepare for the events preceding death.
- Documenting accurate and ongoing assessment of patient status via electronic medical record
- Being available, when possible, to meet a patient/family's need for continuous care in time of crisis.
- Maintaining ongoing effective communication with other hospice personnel involved with patient care

Call volume will vary.
